

Tea Loaf Recipe

Ingredients

300 ml (½ pint) strong tea made with 3 teabags of Earl Grey or English Breakfast
350g (12oz) dried mixed fruit
1 lemon, zest only
2 medium eggs, beaten
250g (90z) self-raising flour
1 tsp mixed spice
200g (7oz) light soft brown sugar

Method

Make the tea in pot or jug and allow it to steep for 10 minutes. Place the fruit and the zest in a bowl and cover with the hot tea, leave to soak overnight.

Preheat the oven to 180°C/ 160°C Fan /Gas 4. Grease and line the base of a 2lb (1kg) loaf tin (approximately 23x13x8cm/9x5x3¼in) with parchment.

Next day, in a bowl beat together the eggs and brown sugar, then stir in the flour, mixed spice and tea-soaked fruit. Mix well to combine.

Pour the mixture into the greased and lined tin and bake for 1¼–1½ hours. The cake is cooked when a skewer comes out clean. Cool in the tin for 15 minutes, then turn out onto a wire rack to cool completely.
